NOVEMBER 20, 2022 | OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, KING OF THE UNIVERSE



Above Jesus on the cross there was an inscription that read,
“This is the King of the Jews.”

~ Luke 23:38

My dear family of St. Pius X and St. Leonard,

They often say that gratitude is the gateway to heaven and that “thank you” is the password to open the gate! As we approach Thanksgiving Day this week, our celebration only ratifies that which we do every single Sunday when we offer back to the Father His Son’s resurrected Body and Blood. Eucharist is synonymous with Thanksgiving because the Eucharist is our supreme act of rendering to God the true worship that he is due. In the prayers of consecration at the mass, the priest says on our behalf, “as we celebrate the memorial of his Death and Resurrection, we offer you, Lord, the Bread of life and the Chalice of salvation, giving thanks that you have held us worthy to be in your presence and minister to you. Humbly we pray that, partaking of the body and blood of Christ, we may be gathered into one by the Holy Spirit.” In other words, our sole purpose for celebrating the Eucharist is our gratitude to God for what he has done for us in Christ. Recalling those gifts disposes our soul more readily for Heaven. We also notice that expressing our gratitude together also unites us more deeply as a community rooted in the Holy Spirit.

I don’t expect for that theology to be prominent in our minds at the Thanksgiving table with our families, but I do hope that a shared awareness of our blessings, a recognition of God’s action in our lives, and the continual hope for his grace will help us to experience in our community and in our homes a deep sense of unity. After all, Thanksgiving forces us to look beyond ourselves to those that have made our lives possible and to humbly acknowledge that we are not alone in this journey. And those two words, “thank you,” will lead us all together right to the pearly gates!

From my perspective as pastor, I am eternally grateful to God for the gift that each of you has become in my life. We are less than six months into our journey of unification as a parish, but it has already become clear how beautiful it is when brothers and sisters dwell in unity. It has been a huge blessing to begin forming new friendships and seeing the different collaborations between parishioners begin to take place. I know that both of our communities have so many gifts to offer that will enrich the Church, and pray that we will always recognize the great treasure that we share in the Eucharist, and the ever-widening network of friends that encourage us along the journey. That experience becomes even more pronounced each day as we work side by side with one another to make our parish something beautiful for God. A special word of thanks to our Catechists and our Guadalupanos for being pioneers in those efforts, and to all our other groups for your love and dedication to our parish family. I hope that you can all make time to join us this week at our Thanksgiving Mass, Thursday at 9am at St. Leonard, as a moving expression of coming together to do what Thanksgiving is ultimately all about. We will be praying for your family this week.

Mi querida familia de San Pío X y de San Leonardo,

¡A menudo se dice que la gratitud es la puerta de entrada al cielo! y que la palabra "gracias" ¡es la contraseña para abrir la puerta! A medida que nos acercamos al Día de Acción de Gracias esta semana, nuestra celebración solo confirma lo que hacemos todos los domingos cuando ofrecemos al Padre el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Su Hijo resucitado. La Eucaristía es sinónimo de acción de gracias porque la Eucaristía es el acto supremo de rendir y ofrecer a Dios el verdadero culto. En las oraciones de consagración en la misa, el sacerdote dice en nuestro nombre: "Mientras celebramos el memorial de su muerte y resurrección, te ofrecemos, Señor, el Pan de vida y el Cáliz de salvación, dando gracias porque nos has considerado dignos de estar en tu presencia para servirte. Oramos humildemente para que, participando del cuerpo y la sangre de Cristo, seamos reunidos en uno por el Espíritu Santo". En otras palabras, el principal propósito de celebrar la Eucaristía es mostrar nuestra gratitud a Dios por lo que ha hecho por nosotros en Cristo. No espero que esta teología esté presente en nuestras mentes en la mesa de Acción de Gracias con nuestras familias, pero sí espero que ayude a tomar una conciencia compartida de nuestras bendiciones, junto a un reconocimiento de la acción de Dios en nuestras vidas, y que la esperanza continua de su gracia nos ayude a experimentar en nuestra comunidad y en nuestros hogares un profundo sentido de unidad. Después de todo, el Día de Acción de Gracias nos ayuda a mirar más allá de nosotros mismos a aquellos que han hecho posible nuestras vidas y a reconocer humildemente que no estamos solos en este peregrinar hacia él. ¡Y que esta palabra, "gracias", nos lleve a todos y a todas a las puertas del cielo!

Desde mi perspectiva como pastor, estoy eternamente agradecido a Dios por el regalo que cada uno de ustedes se ha convertido en mi vida. Llevamos menos de seis meses en nuestro camino de unificación como parroquia, pero ya ha quedado claro lo hermoso que es cuando los hermanos y hermanas viven en unidad. Ha sido una gran bendición comenzar a formar nuevas amistades y ver que diferentes colaboraciones entre los feligreses comienzan a realizarse. Sé que nuestras dos comunidades tienen tantos dones que ofrecer y todo eso enriquecerán a la Iglesia. Pido para que siempre reconozcamos el gran tesoro que compartimos en la Eucaristía y la red cada vez más amplia de amistades que nos animan a lo largo del camino. Esa experiencia se vuelve aún más pronunciada cada día a medida que trabajamos de la mano unos con otros para hacer de nuestra parroquia algo hermoso para Dios. Ofrezco una palabra especial de agradecimiento a nuestros catequistas y nuestros guadalupanos por ser pioneros en estos esfuerzos, y a todos los otros grupos por su amor y dedicación a nuestra familia parroquial. Espero que todos puedan unirse a nosotros este jueves en nuestra Misa de Acción de Gracias a las 9 am en San Leonardo como una expresión de unidad en este Día de Acción de Gracias. Al final de todo, este es nuestro propósito. Estaremos orando por todas nuestras familias esta semana.

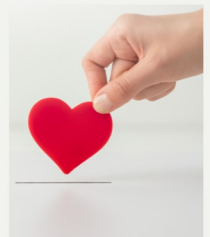
