## Christmas Wafers-Oplatki

The word Oplatki means "Angel Bread." Czech, Polish, Slovak and Lithuanian families observe this centuries old Christmas Tradition. A wafer is given to each present at the Christmas table. The breaking of the wafer is a sign of charity, unity, and friendship. A Wafer bearing a simple design commemorative of Christ's birth is broken by the head of the family and distributed to each member. With a simple prayer for God's grace and the welfare of all present and absent members of the family, a piece of wafer is given to each one at the table. While doing so each member of the family is kissed and is wished a joyful feast. The other family members then greet one another in the same way. The spiritual lesson in this age old custom is unity of the family the main pillar of society. The head of the family is the link in the unbroken chain of One Body, One Christ, and One Church.



La palabra Oplatki significa "Pan de Angel". Familias Checas, Polacas, Eslovacas y Lituanas observan esta tradición navideña de siglos. En la mesa de Navidad se le da una oblea a cada preson. La ruptura de la oblea es un signo de caridad, unidad y amistad. Una oblea con un diseño simple conmemorativo del nacimiento de Cristo es rota por el jefe de la familia y distribuida a cada miembro. Con una simple oración por la gracia de Dios y el bienestar de todos los miembros presentes y ausentes de la familia, se entrega una pieza de oblea a cada uno en la mesa. Al hacerlo, cada miembro de la familia es besado y se le desea una fiesta alegre. Los otros miembros de la familia se saludan unos a otros de la misma manera. La lección espiritual en esta antigua costumbre es la unidad de la familia, el pilar principal de la sociedad. La cabeza de la familia es el eslabón en la cadena ininterrumpida de un Cuerpo, un Cristo, y una Iglesia.

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

In so many ways—large and small—the pandemic has upended our lives together. Families and, in a special way, young people, have faced distressing struggles. The pandemic made our connections with one another challenging and difficult. Exactly in that moment when we truly needed supportive relationships with one another, we found ourselves separated. Sadly, this included the relationships and connections that we have in and through the Church.

We did our best to move forward and many parishes offered on-line Sunday Masses, and went even further and established prayer lines and reached out to those in need. The TV Mass that I celebrated helped to keep us connected as a community of faith in Chicagoland. So many of you have told me how healing and comforting those Masses have been.

In the meanwhile, we are in a new moment. With vaccinations and boosters, restrictions on public gatherings have eased up. Many people feel more comfortable returning to Church. Yet, we know there are some elderly and immuno-compromised persons who are still not ready to return. And they should not return. These vulnerable brothers and sisters have an excusing cause for being absent and for this reason I will continue the TV Mass on ABC for the present time. But for the rest of us, I have decided, in consultation with my advisors, to lift the general dispensation from the obligation of attending Sunday Mass as we begin a new Church year on the First Sunday of Advent, November 26-27.

My hope is that the First Sunday of Advent will provide us with a fresh start to take up again our life together as a community of faith that gathers to worship God. I have asked our pastors to begin the Masses on November 26-27 with the traditional lighting of the Advent wreath. After the homily your pastor will lead the community in a renewal of baptismal promises, acknowledging that we owe our obligation to participate in Sunday Mass to God but also to each other. Our common profession of faith and of our desire to turn away from sin, will be concluded by a sprinkling rite with the waters of baptism.

Let this occasion of our renewal of faith and life, which we all so much want, provide us with a fresh start as we recommit ourselves to worship God and to be supportive of each other week after week as we gather around the Table of the Lord to be nourished and renewed.

Estimadas hermanas y hermanos en Cristo,

De muchas maneras, grandes y pequeñas, la pandemia ha trastocado nuestras vidas juntos. Las familias y, de una manera especial los jóvenes, han enfrentado luchas angustiantes. La pandemia hizo que nuestras conexiones entre nosotros fueran desafiantes y difíciles. Exactamente en ese momento cuando realmente necesitábamos relaciones de apoyo mutuo, nos encontramos separados. Tristemente, esto incluyó las relaciones y conexiones que tenemos en y a través de la Iglesia.

Hicimos nuestro mejor esfuerzo para seguir adelante y estoy orgulloso de nuestra respuesta colectiva a los desafíos de la pandemia. Cuando anuncié una dispensación general de la obligación de participar en la misa del domingo, muchas parroquias ofrecieron las misas del domingo en línea, y fueron incluso más allá y establecieron líneas de oración y se acercaron a los necesitados. La misa televisada que celebré ayudó a mantenernos conectados como comunidad de fe en el área de Chicago. Muchos de ustedes me han dicho cuan sanadoras y reconfortantes han sido esas misas.

Mientras tanto, estamos en un momento nuevo. Con las vacunas y los refuerzos, las restricciones a las reuniones públicas se han relajado. Muchas personas se sienten más cómodas regresando a la iglesia. Sin embargo, sabemos que hay algunas personas mayores e inmunocomprometidas que todavía no están listas para regresar. Y ellas no deben regresar. Estos hermanos y hermanas vulnerables tienen una causa que justifica estar ausentes y por esta razón continuaré la misa televisada por ABC por el momento. Pero para el resto de nosotros, he decidido, en consulta con mis asesores, suspender la dispensación general de la obligación de asistir a la misa del domingo al comenzar un nuevo año eclesiástico el Primer Domingo de Adviento, el 26-27 de noviembre.

Mi esperanza es que el Primer Domingo de Adviento nos brindará un nuevo comienzo para retomar nuestra vida juntos como una comunidad de fe que se reúne para adorar a Dios. He pedido a nuestros párrocos que comiencen las misas el 26-27 de noviembre con el tradicional encendido de la corona de Adviento. Después de la homilía, su párroco dirigirá a la comunidad en una renovación de las promesas bautismales, reconociendo que nuestra obligación de participar en la misa dominical se la debemos a Dios pero también unos a otros. Nuestra común profesión de fe y de nuestro deseo de apartarnos del pecado, será concluida con un rito de aspersion con las aguas del bautismo.

Permitamos que esta ocasión de nuestra renovación de fe y vida, que todos queremos tanto, nos proporcione un nuevo comienzo mientras nos volvemos a comprometer a adorar a Dios y a apoyarnos unos a otros semana tras semana mientras nos reunimos alrededor de la Mesa del Señor para ser nutridos y renovados.

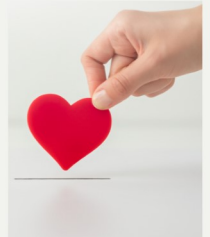
