My dear St. Leonard Family,

As we approach the Renew My Church process as a parish, I want us as a parish family to first take stock of the mission of Jesus Christ, which is also the mission of the Church. Any authentic process of renewal must always be grounded in that mission and lead to a deeper flourishing of it. In our efforts to create strong, hospitable, vibrant parish communities, we sometimes run the risk of losing track of the discipleship impulse that underlies it all. "Go, make disciples of all nations," Jesus says, "Baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." Cardinal George, God rest His soul, was fond of reminding us that the Church is not simply a club, a voluntary association of people who like hanging out together. Rather, the Church is firstly a Communion, sharing in the unity of the Holy Trinity, transformed and charged by Divine Grace, and intimately united to Jesus as His Body continuing to live out the Paschal Mystery here on Earth. In other words, every disciple is not merely a member of the Church, but also another Christ, a missionary of His Kingdom. And the missionary mandate given to us all is to introduce the world to its Savior, extending the offer of authentic friendship, forgiveness and freedom from sin, and life in abundance that He provides.

It's helpful for us to remember that this is why our parishes exist. Of course, our parish becomes a spiritual home, a place where that relationship with Christ and His Church is nourished and strengthened. But the Parish is also always meant to be a school of discipleship, a training ground for proclaiming the Kingdom, and the central place of life-changing encounters with the power of Jesus. For that reason, the parish always looks beyond itself: "Every Christian," says Pope Francis, "is challenged, here and now, to be actively engaged in evangelization; indeed, anyone who has truly experienced God's saving love does not need much time or lengthy training to go out and proclaim that love... we no longer say that we are 'disciples' and 'missionaries,' but rather that we are always 'missionary disciples.'"

This truly was the experience of the first Christian communities, missionary disciples who left behind all the comforts of the world they knew in order to proclaim Christ's love and forgiveness to the ends of the earth. But it's also the experience of every vibrant Christian community in every age. Whether Franciscans who embrace radical poverty as a testimony to their total dependence on God, Cistercians who become masters at interpreting the inner promptings of God's grace, parents whose love becomes the sacrament of God's infinite love for His people, or priests who welcome sanctity into the ordinary moments of our lives: all are missionary disciples whose words and actions proclaim that their lives and their communities have been brushed with God's grace. And at the end of the day, that's the benchmark for the renewal of our parishes as we strive more earnestly to live as radical disciples for Christ.

Mi querida familia de San Leonardo,

Como parte de nuestro proceso de Renueva Mi Iglesia, quiero tomar un momento como familia parroquial para considerar la misión de Jesucristo, que también es la misión de la Iglesia. Cualquier proceso de renovación siempre tiene que ser fundado en esa misión y llevarnos a un florecimiento de ella. En nuestros esfuerzos para crear una comunidad fuerte, hospitable, y vibrante, corremos el riesgo de perder el sentido del impulso del discipulado que la sustenta. "Vayan, entonces, y hagan que todos los pueblos sean mis discípulos," dice Jesús, "bautizándolos en el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo." Cardenal George, que en paz descanse, nos recordaba con cariño que la iglesia no es un club, un grupo de personas que les gusta salir juntos. No, antes que nada, la iglesia es una comunión, compartiendo la unidad de la Santísima Trinidad, transformada y cargada con la gracia divina, e íntimamente unida a Jesús como su Cuerpo viviendo aquí en el mundo su misterio pascual continuo. En otras palabras, cada discípulo no es solamente un miembro de la iglesia, sino también otro Cristo, un misionero de su reino. Y el mandato misionero que tenemos es presentarle al mundo a su salvador, ofreciendo la oferta de su amistad auténtica, el perdón del pecado y la libertad, y la vida en abundancia que él nos da.

Por esto existen nuestras parroquias. Claro, la parroquia también es un hogar espiritual, un lugar en donde esa relación con Cristo y su iglesia se alimenta y se fortalece. Pero la parroquia también es una escuela del discipulado, un campo del entrenamiento para proclamar el Reino, y el lugar central de nuestros encuentros con el poder de Jesús que transforman la vida. Por esa razón, la parroquia siempre mira más allá que sí mismo. "Es un llamado para cada cristiano," dice el Papa Francisco, "para que nadie postergue su compromiso con la evangelización, pues si uno de verdad ha hecho una experiencia del amor de Dios que lo salva, no necesita mucho tiempo de preparación para salir a anunciarlo, no puede esperar que le den muchos cursos o largas instrucciones... ya no decimos que somos 'discípulos' y 'misioneros', sino que somos siempre 'discípulos misioneros.'"

Esto realmente era la experiencia de las primeras comunidades cristianas, discípulos misioneros que dejaron todo de las comodidades del mundo que conocían para poder proclamar el amor y el perdón de Cristo hacía los últimos rincones de la tierra. Esto también es la experiencia de cada comunidad cristiana vibrante en todo momento. O sea Franciscanos que viven una pobreza radical como testimonio de su dependencia total de Dios, o los Cistercienses que se hacen expertos en interpretar las instigaciones de la gracia de Dios, o los padres de familia cuyo amor se convierte en un sacramento del amor infinito de Dios para su pueblo, o los sacerdotes que abren nuestras vidas ordinarias a la gracia y la santidad de Dios: todos son discípulos misioneros cuyas palabras y acciones proclaman que sus vidas y sus comunidades han sido tocado con la gracia de Dios. Y al final del día, esto también es la medida que nosotros tenemos para renovar nuestras parroquias y esforzarnos a vivir como discípulos radicales para Cristo.

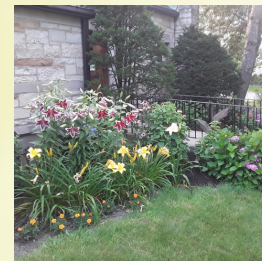

The St. Leonard Garden Club needs help with a special project the evening of Tuesday, July 20. Earlier this year, we received a free truck-load of EQ compost from the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District.

Some has been spread around the church gardens, but we still have a lot of ground to cover and hope to finish the job this week. We're looking for volunteers of all ages to help fill wheelbarrows and containers and spread the compost around the grounds. Can you help for an hour or two between 6 p.m. and 8 p.m. on Tuesday the 20th? After 8 p.m. that day and in the days following, parishioners are invited to bring compost home for your own flower gardens. The compost pile can be found off the alley by the southwest corner of the school. Bring gloves if you have them. We have one wheelbarrow and a number of containers, we could use another wheelbarrow or two if that's something you can bring on Tuesday.
